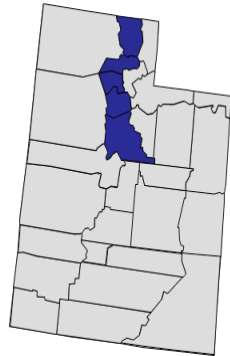

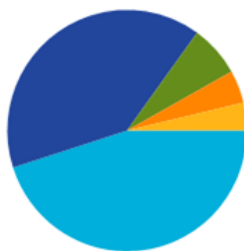

AVID National Demonstration Schools

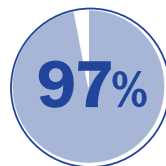
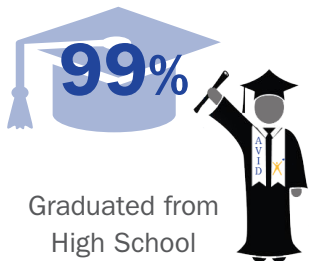
